



**NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL OFFICES
to be voted on in the Morgan City General Election
November 7, 2023**

In accordance with UCA 10-3-301(2)(a) – Notice is hereby given the offices of three (3) City Council seats are to be voted upon in the Morgan City 2023 Municipal Election. Each position has a four-year term and are “at-large,” meaning they are open to candidates city-wide.

Interested residents of Morgan City may become candidates by filing a Declaration of Candidacy in the Morgan City Recorder’s Office. Declaration of Candidacy Forms or Nomination Petitions must be filed **in person** with the City Recorder at 90 West Young Street, Morgan, Utah, between regular office hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. – Thursday, June 1, 2023 through Wednesday, June 7, 2023, excluding Saturday and Sunday.

MUNICIPAL CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

- Be a United States citizen at the time of filing.
- Be a registered voter of Morgan City.
- Be a resident of Morgan City for at least 12 consecutive months prior to the date of the election.
- Be mentally competent, have not been convicted of a felony, and have not been convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise, unless right to hold office has been restored pursuant to UCA 20A-2-101.

Utah Code §20A-2-101 states: A registered voter (1) is a citizen of the United States; (2) is a resident of Utah for at least the 30 days immediately before the election; (3) will be on the date of that election, at least 18 years old; (4) currently resides within the voting district which the individual applies to register to vote; and (5) and is registered to vote.

Utah Code §20A-2-101.5 states: A person convicted of a felony loses the right to hold office until (1) all felony convictions have been expunged, OR (2) ten years have passed since the most recent felony conviction AND the person has paid all court-ordered restitution and fines AND the person has completed probation, been granted parole, or completed the term of incarceration associated with the felony.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023. If sufficient candidates file, a Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 15, 2023. Morgan City will be holding its election by-mail only. Ballots can be mailed or put in the official ballot boxes located at the Morgan County Office at 48 West Young Street, Morgan, Utah.
