

NOTICE OF ELECTION – 2017

Morgan City will hold elections for Mayor and two City Council seats. The seats are "at-large," meaning they are open to candidates city-wide. Each position has a four-year term.

Interested residents of Morgan City may become candidates by filing a Declaration of Candidacy at the City Recorder's Office between Thursday, June 1, 2017, and Wednesday, June 7, 2017, during regular business hours.

Candidates must be: 1) a United States Citizen; 2) at least 18 years of age; 3) a registered voter of Morgan City; 4) a resident of Morgan City or recently annexed area for a period of 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the election (November 7, 2017); and 5) not be a convicted felon, unless the right to hold elective office has been restored.

Regular Council meetings are held the second and fourth Tuesday of each month beginning at 6:00 p.m. Councilmembers are expected to attend other meetings and functions as part of their duties and assignments. Candidates should be willing and able to spend the time required to represent the citizens of the City.

The general election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017. If sufficient candidates file, a primary election will be held on Tuesday, August 15, 2017.
